Despite ostensible support from the federal government from the renewable energy and a confirmation of commitment to energy transition within the United States, some areas around capital deployment and effects on the market still seem very unclear as the bill has a far reaching mandate



Resilience and reliability are tied; grid systems have been plagued by climate related reliability issues. Without the flexibility of multiple generation source technology working together on the grid, we open ourselves up to continued problems.



Outdated power lines and access to interconnection sites paired with more frequent extreme weather have highlighted that transmission infrastructure investment is critical for a viable fully electrified system.




New technologies continue to find new decarbonization pathways but financing structures, credit committees and regulatory standards often stand in their way. Bi-Directional EV charging, hydrogen, long duration storage for example still seem out of reach without better support.
